This whimsical model is a scale replica of Henry Ford's revolutionary 1914 Model T Speedster. This particular design is a variation on an original Model T, one of the very first designs to roll off of Henry Ford's now famous assembly line. By mass producing these cars, Henry Ford made practical, effective transportation accessible to the common middle-class American. This important turn in American history bridged great distances that permanently altered the landscape, infrastructure, and tone of American culture at this time. This is a working toy car that will seat two children. This model was originally manufactured by McDonough Power Equipment Inc., located in McDonough, GA. in 1970. It is powered by a Briggs & Stratton gasoline engine and has a metal body with fiberglass fenders. Other details include inflatable tires with wooden spoked wheels just like the original. This rugged little powered car has a real working steering wheel and is likely to be the delight of children and car enthusiasts young and old alike.
