The gooseneck spigot (or faucet) is a design that is still used today in the modern hardware. This particular spigot is made from bronze and is a literal embodiment of this design concept, having a goose's head as the spout. It was salvaged from Martha's Vineyard and was perhaps used in a tavern to dispense beer.
