Made by The Samuel Yellin Company. A magnificent example of the medieval and Renaissance inspired ironwork created for buildings across the U.S. Yellin was America's master iron craftsman of the 20th century. With his staff of over 200 craftspeople, he created hundreds of designs for gates, lighting fixtures, screens, grilles, railings and doorways for residences, cathedrals, banks and academic buildings. His commissions include the private residences of J.P. Morgan, Henry Clay Frick, Andrew Mellon and Cornelius Vanderbilt Whitney as well as public buildings such as St. Patrick's Cathedral, the Washington National Cathedral, Harvard, Yale and Princeton University.
