This rare cast iron and steel barber pole was made by the Koken Manufacturing Company in St. Louis, Missouri. This salvaged item is still in its original condition.

In the late 19th century Ernest Koken invented and manufactured the first hydraulic Koken barber chair. In its time, the Koken barber chair represented state of the art craftsmanship and was regarded as a reference model for barber chairs. At St. Lois the Koken manufacturing co. still operates and produces stylish and durable chairs for the barber and beauty industry.
