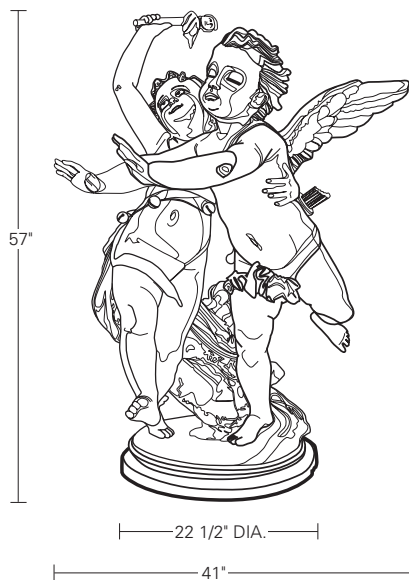


CHERUB STATUE

(FROM THE VAL D'OSNE FOUNDRY; PARIS, FRANCE)

Cast in iron at the Val D'Osne foundry in Paris, France c.1840, the piece itself depicts two playful cherubs, and would typically be found in or around a reflecting pool. Details of the open-eyed cherub on the left include a belled sash around its torso, and a jester faced scepter raised in its right hand. The close-eyed cherub on the right features detailed feathered wings, and a quiver slung on its back. Together, they stand 57 inches tall. The base of the statue bears the mark of the Val D'Osne foundry where the statue was forged, as well as the street name and number; "58B Voltaire, Paris."
