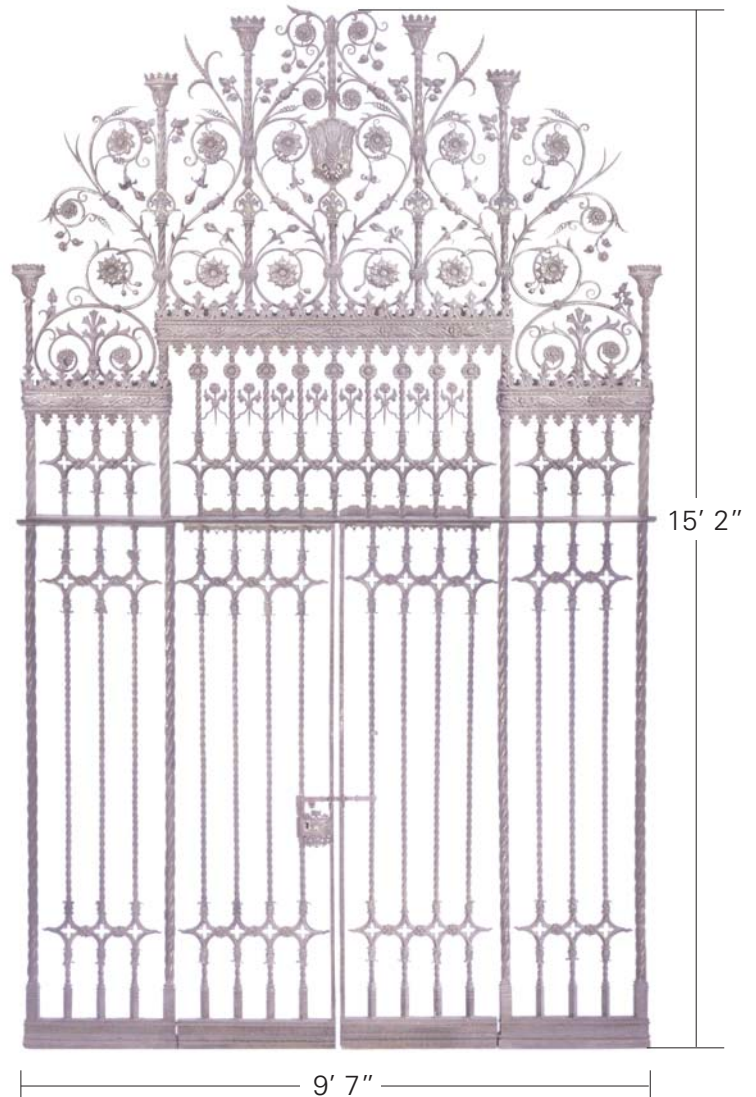


WROUGHT IRON GOTHIC GATES

(FROM THE ORIGINAL ST. PATRICK'S CATHEDRAL;
MULBERRY STREET, MANHATTAN)

Originally installed in Saint Patrick's Cathedral, these intricate wrought iron gates are not only an important part of New York City history, but stand as a lasting monument to gothic design. Having been attributed to acclaimed ironsmith Samuel Yellin and his workshop, the importance of this piece becomes even more significant. The master's influence is quite evident upon examination of the twisting, organic forms crowning the gates. Yellin's work remains a benchmark for metalwork until present day. Originally acquired from Kenneth Lynch, a premier metalsmith in his own right, the gates have found a home as part of Urban Archaeology's collection. The piece is available for acquisition through our Franklin Street showroom.
