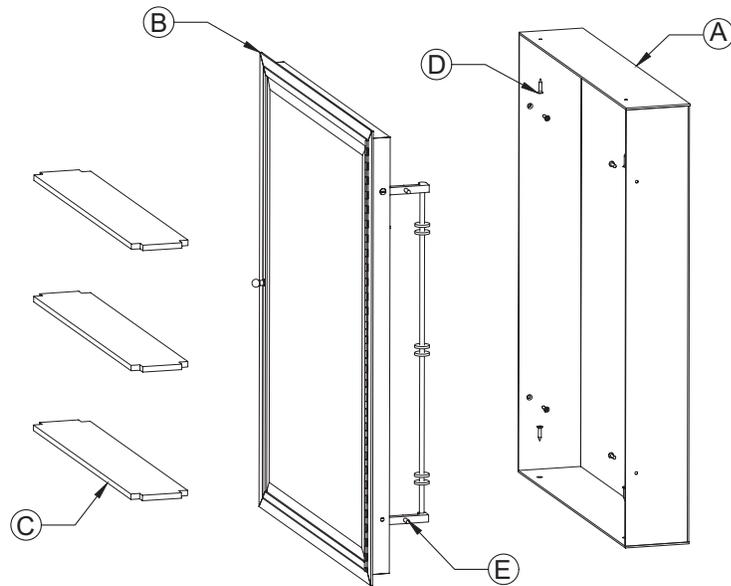
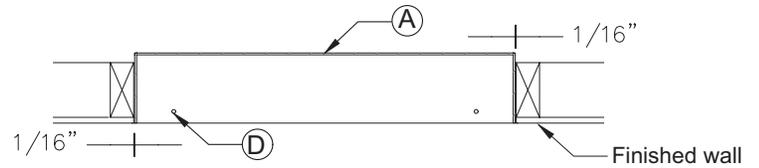


Lenox Cabinet — Installing Stainless Steel Box

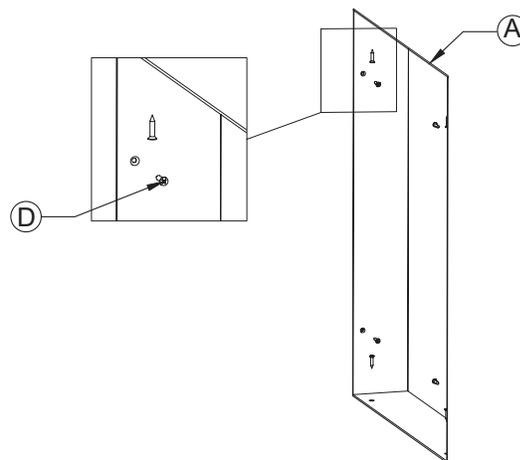
- A. Stainless steel box
- B. Door frame and shelf brackets
- C. Glass shelves
- D. Box screws
- E. Bracket screws



1. The stainless steel box [A] is 1" smaller than the outside dimension of the frame [B]. The opening in the wall for the box is 1/8" larger than the outside dimension of the box, allowing a 1/16" gap on each side between the box and the blocking.

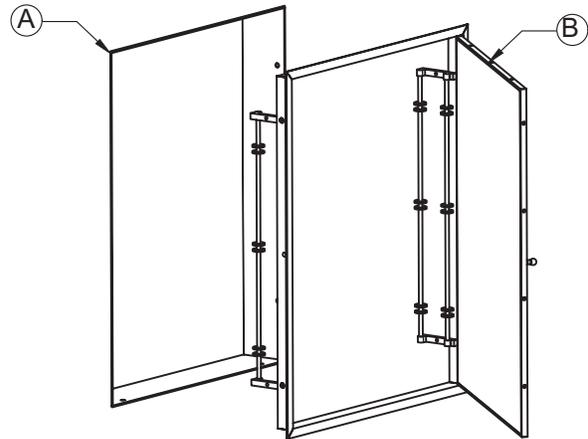


2. Set Box [A] in wall so front edge of box is flush with finished wall. Fasten with the box screws [D] the stainless steel box [A] from each side through the predrilled holes.

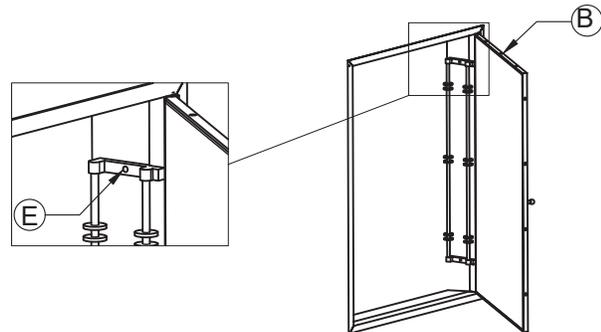


Lenox Cabinet — Installing Stainless Steel Box

3. Insert door frame [B] fully into the stainless steel box [A] with the door open. Check alignment of the cabinet frame. Ensure door opens and close.



4. After insert the frame [B] drill the holes in the stainless steel box through the shelf brackets [E] and screw through it into the blocking.



5. Slide the glass shelves [C] between the Knurled washers and secure them.
